

Sec. 19-28. Water use restriction.

Use of the city water supply system for lawn and garden sprinkling, irrigation, car washing or other nonpotable uses shall be limited to an odd-even schedule corresponding to property address effective each year from May 1 to September 30. Whenever the city council or, on a temporary basis, the public works director and/or the city manager or city manager's designee, shall determine that a shortage of the water supply threatens the city, they may further limit the days and hours during which water may be used from the city water supply system. Special permit consideration will be given for those property owners with new seed or sod if in the opinion of the public works director sufficient water for such permits is available.

Property owners installing an automatic or underground irrigation system are required to install a rain sensor device. Existing irrigation systems are required to retrofit to install a rain sensor device at such time as improvement or extension of the system valued at or above \$1,000.00 or requiring a plumbing permit are done.

The first violation of the provisions of this section in any calendar year shall result in a written warning from the city. Subsequent violations will result in a penalty fee schedule approved by city council. The penalty will be added to the next water bill for the premises.
